THREE EVWD BOARD SEATS UP FOR ELECTION IN NOVEMBER *Candidate Filing Begins July 16 Through August 10*

Highland, Calif., (July 11, 2018) – Governed by a 5-member Board of Directors who serve as policy makers of the organization, East Valley Water District will have three board seats up for election this November. Community members interested in running are encouraged to visit the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters offices to request candidate filing documents. Candidate filing begins July 16, 2018 and closes on August 10, 2018 at 5:00 pm.

“The democratic process is essential to effective governance,” said John Mura, General Manager/CEO. “We encourage active participation in all of our activities, including the selection of our Board of Directors through local elections.”

The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters serves as the election officer and is responsible for all candidates' filings, the issuance and acceptance of nomination papers. Registrar of Voters offices are located at 777 E. Rialto Avenue, San Bernardino, CA 92415. Applicants must be registered voters living within the District's service area, over 18 years of age, and have not been convicted of a crime that would prevent them from holding a public office. The 2018 elections will be conducted at polling locations along with the General Election. Board members are elected to staggered 4-year terms.
