Regular maintenance and repair is an important element to ensuring reliable service. East Valley Water District (District) will begin a wastewater (also known as sewer) pipeline replacement project on 35th Street between Modesto Drive and Conejo Drive, and Modesto Drive between 35th and 36th Street starting January 14, 2019. The project is expected to be completed in early February, depending on weather conditions.

On January 14 - 18, the District's contractor, TK Construction, will begin digging to locate existing utilities. On January 22, construction will begin with the replacement of a sewer main on 35th Street. For this replacement, there will be a temporary disruption to your wastewater services and no disruption to your water services.

Residents identified on the map are asked to refrain from the use of items that drain to the public wastewater between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

TK Construction will be replacing a wastewater pipeline and will temporarily block your drain flows.

Use of these items during this time may cause a wastewater overflow into your home.

Please see the map on the back of this notice for more information on the homes impacted by this project. TK Construction will also provide a notice with project information to all residents impacted by the project prior to the beginning of construction.

Please remember to be cautious while driving through the construction zone. For the safety of other motorists and construction crews, please observe all warning signs. In addition, there will be no parking on the streets during this project. Thank you for your patience as we complete this project. These improvements represent a significant investment in maintaining a reliable wastewater system for the community served by the District.

IMPORTANT PROJECT DETAILS

DATES

Phase 1: Locating Existing Utilities, January 14 - 18, 2019

Phase 2: Sewer Main Replacement, Manhole Rehabilitation, Street Pavement Overlay, January 22 - February 8, 2019

TRAFFIC

Temporary lane closures on 35th Street and Modesto Drive will be in place to allow for equipment and operational vehicles in the roadway. Residents and emergency vehicles will have access throughout the project.

WASTEWATER SERVICE

This construction will require a temporary disruption to your wastewater services and no disruption to your water services. Customers will receive a door tag notification approximately 24 - 48 hours before the interruption of services.

Residents identified on Modesto Drive and 35th Street are asked to minimize the use of toilets and refrain from using showers, washing machines, and any other items that drain to the public wastewater between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

MODESTO DRIVE WASTEWATER PIPELINE REPLACEMENT

The District has identified a 1,000-foot section of wastewater pipeline along 35th Street and Modesto Drive that needs to be replaced to a larger diameter pipeline. By replacing the undersized sewer main, the potential of a future blockage occurring is significantly reduced.

The current Sewer Master Plan identified the need for a number of capital improvement projects. Selection of these projects have been based on the evaluation of the positive impact that they will each have on customers, maintaining existing facilities, and continuing to meet local, state, and federal requirements.

Shaded residences will be directly impacted by the scheduled project.
