In providing reliable service, the District makes regular maintenance and repairs an important element of our water system improvement efforts. East Valley Water District (District) will begin a water main line replacement project on Yuma Drive and Piedmont Drive starting November 4, 2019. This project will be performed in phases and is expected to be completed in early December 2019, depending on weather conditions.

On November 4 - 8, District staff will be in your neighborhood surveying the streets to locate existing utility lines. On November 12, construction will begin on Yuma Drive. During this replacement, there will be a brief temporary interruption to your water services.

Please see the map on the back of this notice for more information on the homes that will be impacted by this project. Construction is scheduled to take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:30 am – 4:00 pm. Street parking will be unavailable during this project.

In Phase 3, the District's contractor, Mike Roquet Construction Inc., will make repairs to the pavement. Notices for no street parking will be placed in your street 24 - 48 hours before paving begins.

Please be cautious while driving through the work zone. For the safety of other motorists and construction crews, please follow all warning signs. We appreciate your patience as we make improvements to the water system. These upgrades represent a significant investment in maintaining a reliable water system for the community served by the District.

IMPORTANT PROJECT DETAILS

APPROXIMATE DATES

Phase 1: Locating Existing Utilities, November 4 - 8, 2019

Phase 2: Water Main Replacement, Fire Hydrant Installation
November 12 - late November 2019

Phase 3: Street Pavement Repairs, early December 2019

TRAFFIC & PARKING (Phase 2)

Temporary lane closures on Yuma Drive will be in place to allow for equipment and operational vehicles in the roadway. Residents and emergency vehicles will have access throughout the project. Street parking will be unavailable during this project.

WATER SERVICES (Phase 2)

During construction, there will be a temporary disruption of about 45 minutes to your water services. Customers will receive a door tag notification 24 - 48 hours before the interruption of services.

STREET PAVEMENT REPAIRS (Phase 3)

This project will include pavement repairs. In this phase, water and sewer services will not be impacted but street parking may be limited.

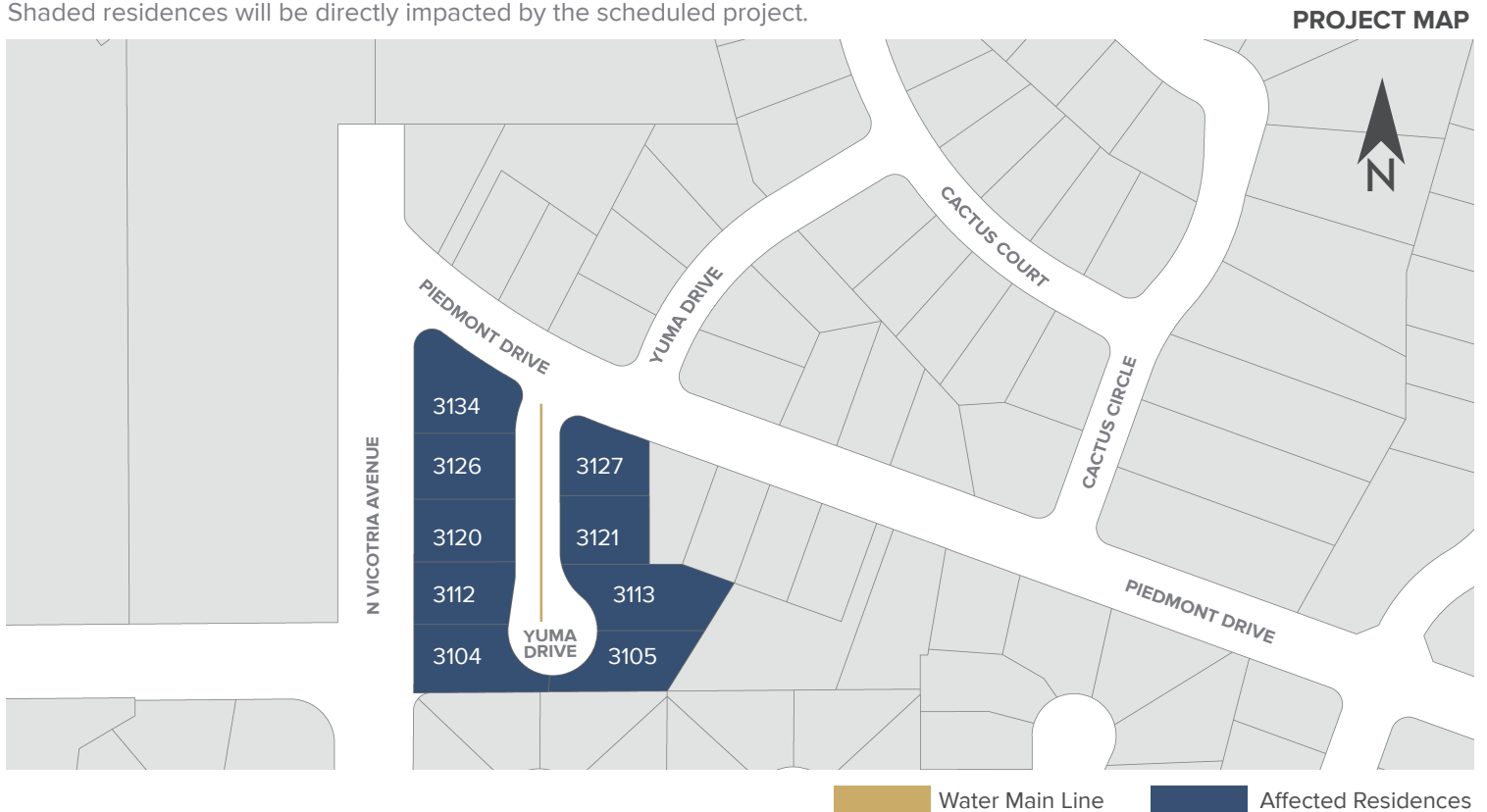
ABOUT THE PROJECT

WATER MAIN LINE REPLACEMENT ON YUMA DRIVE

The District has identified a water main line on Yuma Drive and Piedmont Drive that needs to be replaced with a larger pipeline. By replacing the undersized water pipeline, the need for maintenance and leak repairs is significantly reduced. Additional project enhancements include the installation of a fire hydrant to assist the fire department during an emergency, as well as aid in the maintenance of the water system.

The current Water Master Plan identified the need for a number of capital improvement projects. Selection of these projects have been based on the evaluation of the positive impact that they will each have on customers, maintaining existing facilities, and continuing to meet local, state, and federal requirements.

Shaded residences will be directly impacted by the scheduled project.
